Together, these create the perfect balance of high impact learning experiences that engage and excite learners. This session, designed specifically for principals and leadership teams, empowers leaders to integrate evidence-based approaches that include:

- Instructional materials comprised of both informational and narrative texts.
- The best uses of instructional delivery modes, including direct and dialogic instruction.
- Grouping patterns that work best to accomplish learning aims for different learners at different stages.
- Instruction in foundational skills and meaning making, including oral language development, phonemic awareness, phonics, fluency, vocabulary, comprehension, and writing.
- Technology used as a tool for increasing learning of a specific literary process.

Tap your intuition, collaborate with your peers, and put the research-based strategies embedded in this roadmap to work in your school to implement or deepen a strong, successful balanced literacy program. Grow as a literacy leader while leading your students to grow as readers and writers.
